

The Hinson Family Ensemble comes to Hornsea

With the excitement of the Hornsea Music Festival still fresh in our minds, many people will remember the constructive and helpful comments on the performances made by the team of adjudicators. They were clearly fine musicians, with a real passion for passing on their knowledge to others and getting people to join in with the world of music.

One of the adjudicators, Nadia Hinson, will return to the town in September, this time as a performer. She will bring three members of her family to open the Hornsea Music Society's concert season. All four of the Hinsons are professional musicians with a good reputation nationwide. Together they play a mixture of classical and light classical music arranged for strings and woodwind. They are based centrally in Nottingham, which is convenient for travelling to the regular concerts they give around the country.

Their repertoire is so broad that, as Society Chairman Roberta Loades says, "On the night, anything could happen." Why not put Saturday 17th September in your diary? Come along at 7.30 and see if Roberta was right.

Hornsea Music Society believe that it is important for live classical music to be available in the town, and tries to get the best talent to enhance the cultural life of the town. They aim to keep ticket prices affordable, to widen access for members of the community and visitors.

Many of the musicians who play at these regular concerts comment that Hornsea is very lucky, as it is one of a dwindling number of towns to still have a music society organising events. Make the most of your opportunities, and come along to the Hornsea United Reformed Church to hear the Hinson Family in the first concert of the season.
